SPECIAL ADDRESS BY THE GOVERNOR, HIS EXCEL-LENCY SHRI SRI PRAKASA, UNDER ARTICLE 176 (1) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA TO THE MEMBERS OF THE MADRAS LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY AND COUNCIL ASSEMBLED TOGETHER AT THE ASSEM-BLY CHAMBER, GOVERNMENT ESTATE, MOUNT ROAD, AT 5 P.M. ON TUESDAY, 6TH MAY 1952.

Tuesday, the 6th May 1952.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR'S ADDRESS.

His Excellency on arrayal was received at the main porch of the Legislative Assembly by the Speaker (Hon. Sr. J., Sivashanmugam Pillai), the Chairman (Hon. Dr. P. V. Cherian), the Secretary to the State Legislature and the Deputy Secretary to the Council.

His Excellency was led in a procession by the Secretary and the Deputy Secretary and the Chairman and the Speaker, and conducted to the dais.

The arrival of His Excellency the Governor was announced by the Assistant Secretary to the Members who stood up as His Excellency entered the Chamber. The Members sat down after the Governor took his seat on the dais. The Hon, Speaker sat on the right side of His Excellency and the Hon. Chairman on his left.

His Excellency rose to deliver his Address. Then the hon. Member Sri T. Prakasam rose to what he called 'a point of order' and made a speech. After making the speech, he and several Members of the two Chambers left the hall. The Governor then delivered the following Address:—

"Hon'ble Members of the Legislature,

With this session of the State Legislature, we commence a new chapter in the history of our State. Before I proceed further, I would like to express on behalf of our State our regret at the passing away of King George VI, the Head of the Commonwealth of which our Republic has elected to be a member. The late King worthily upheld the great traditions of the British monarchy and endeared himself to all. We send our people's respectful greetings and good wishes to Queen Elizabeth.

'This is the first session of the State Legislature as constituted in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of India, and I congratulate you on being members of this historic legislature. A democratic Constitution like ours will be largely what the voters and legislators make of it. The voters have done their part, and it is up to you, the legislators, to help in volving sound traditions.

'In his Address at the commencement of the last session of the old legislature, my predecessor assured the Hon'ble Members of that legislature, and through them, the general public, that the Government were determined to do all that lay in their power to ensure that the general elections were conducted with absolute impartiality and fairness to all the contesting parties and candidates, and appealed for the co-operation of all the parties for achieving that result. I think we may claim that that assurance has been fulfilled. The largest share of the credit for this result must go to the several millions of voters, men and women, who exercised their franchies in an orderly manner.

'My Government assumed office on 10th April 1952. Owing to the shortness of time between that date and now, my Address will not cover as much matter as ordinarily, at the beginning of a session, the Address may be expected to deal with. We could not possibly postpone this sitting in view of clause (1) of Article 382 of the Constitution. After completing the necessary business at this sitting, it has been decided that you will be called upon to gather again in June and I shall address you again at the commencement of that sitting under clause (1) of Article 175. At that sitting of the Legislature, the full Budget for the current financial year will have to be passed, and it will be an occasion when there can be a comprehensive review of all matters which are important from the point of view of the welfare and development of the State.

' During the financial year 1951-52, this State experienced a failure of both the monsoons for the fifth year in succession. Cultivation of food crops suffered most seriously in four entire districts and in parts of six other districts. Relief measures have been extended to the affected areas by the grant of liberal wet and dry remissions and by providing relief works for labourers thrown out of employment by reason of this drought. Then collection of takkavi instalments has been postponed till the next fasli year in these Takkavi and subsistence loans and loans for deepening field wells are also being sanctioned on a liberal scale in the affected areas. To meet the distress caused by the drought, drinkingwater wells are being deepened in a large number of places. The Army of India is rendering great assistance in this respect. number of water lorries have been loaned by them for distribution of water in the areas where scarcity of drinking water is most acute. Gruel centres have been opened in large numbers and free gruel is served to infirm and disabled persons and to women and children. The Government of India have sent a large quantity of multivitamin tablets and milk powder for distribution in the areas of To relieve scarcity of fodder, the reserved forests in the districts of Cuddapah, Chittoor and Anantapur have been thrown open for free grazing, and free removal of hill grass. Arrangements have also been made to import fodder and grass from the surplus districts and to sell them at concessional rates to the rvots in the drought affected districts, where purchasing power has been 6th May 1952]

considerably reduced. Several voluntary organizations have offered free gifts of fodder and grain and transport facilities have been arranged at State cost for moving them to the affected areas. The Prime Minister of India has most generously assisted us from his Relief Fund. A Madras State Famine Relief Fund has been organized and I trust there will be good response to our appeal.

- The Government of India have assisted us to find ways and means accommodation to the extent of two crores of rupees by purchasing securities held by the State Government and have agreed to make a free grant not exceeding Rs. 48 lakhs to help run gruel centres. We are most grateful to the Government of India and to the woluntary organizations for all their assistance. My Government will endeavour to give adequate relief in all the areas where there is distress on account of the failure of the monsoons.
- Owing to the successive failure of the monsoons during the last five years, the food situation in the State continues to be difficult. The latest estimates indicate that the production of rice this year will be less than the normal by nearly 10 lakhs tons and the production of millets by nearly 4 lakhs tons. Allotments by the Government of India from the All-India pool will be mostly in the shape of wheat and millo and the rice quota is expected to be less than 2 lakhs tons. As against this, it may be noted that we have been lucky to some extent in seasonal conditions in the surplus districts, and there is no reason to apprehend that there will be any deterioration in procurement. The Government of India have permitted this State to increase the procurement price of paddy by one rupee per maund up to the end of May this year in addition to the increase of eight annas per maund sanctioned in December last. This will not affect the consumer's prices.
 - 'The recent general slump has resulted in considerable distress to those engaged in the large handloom industry of this State. My Government are giving anxious thought to this subject and will announce the measures which they propose to take after consulting all the interests concerned.
 - There is an argent piece of legislation to be put through at this meeting of the legislature. It relates to immovable properties which were requisitioned for purposes of the State Government under the Defence of India Rules during the last War and which continued to be subject to requisition under Central Act XVII of 1947, the life of which was extended for a period of one year from 1st April 1951 by Madras Act II of 1951. As the work of derequisitioning of these properties could not be completed before the end of March 1952, immediate action had to be taken to extend the life of the Central Act referred to, for a further period of one year from 1st April 1952. The Requisitioned Land (Continuance of Powers) (Madras Amendment) Amendment Ordinance, 1952 (Madras Ordinance I of 1952), extending the life of the Central Act till 1st April 1953 in respect of immovable properties requisitioned for State purposes, was promulgated on the

31st March 1952. A self-contained Bill replacing this Ordinance will be introduced during the present sittings of the legislature.

'I have done. I am sure that your debates and deliberations in this and future sittings of the new legislature of this State will be conducted with the same high sense of public duty and responsibility as in the past, and I pray that you may be guided by faith, courage and wisdom in your counsels.'"

His Excellency then left the Chamber accompanied by the Hon. Speaker and the Hon. Chairman.

The Members of the Assembly and the Council then dispersed.

FIRST SESSION OF THE FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTED UNDER THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

The House met in the Assembly Chamber, Government Estate, Mount Road, Madras, at eleven of the clock, Temporary Speaker (THE HON. SRI P. T. RAJAN) in the Chair.

I .- SWEARING-IN OF MEMBERS.

TEMPORARY SPEAKER (Sri P.T. Rajan):—"Hon. Members are no doubt aware that I have been appointed by His Excellency the Governor under clause (1) of Article 180 of the Constitution of India to perform the duties of the office of the Speaker of the Madras Legislative Assembly till a Speaker is chosen under Article 178 of the Constitution. I have great pleasure in welcoming you to this first meeting of the new State Legislative Assembly constituted under the Constitution of India.

"Under Article 188 of the Constitution of India, hon. Members have to take the prescribed oath before taking their seats, and I have been appointed by His Excellency as the person before whom they should take the prescribed oath.

"In accordance with the practice followed in the Legislature, I propose to ask the Secretary to call upon the Hon. Ministers first to take the oath, then the Leader of the Official Opposition, the Leaders of Parties whose names have been sent to the Legislature office, the ex-Ministers, the ex-Speaker, the Government Whip and then hon. Members in the order in which their names appear in the alphabetical list of members of the Madras Legislative Assembly.

"Members will be called upon in twos and as they are called they are requested to approach the Secretary's table for the purpose of taking the oath. Forms of oath or affirmation to be made by them will be handed over to them by the Secretary.

"After taking the oath or making an affirmation and after signing their names in the register kept for the purpose, hon. Members will be entitled to take their seats as Members of the Assembly. I may say, except for the Members of the Government. no seats have yet been reserved. The Speaker who 6th May will allot seats under Rule is to be elected on 51 in consultation, no doubt, with the Leaders of concerned. In the meantime, hon, Members may Parties occupy any available seat in the House. I know it would be tedious for hon. Members to sit for long in their seats doing nothing and simply watching other Members taking their oath before the Speaker. But the solemnity of the occasion would require their attention and presence throughout in the House, and I would therefore request hon. Members to remain in their seats till after the last Member has taken his oath.
